Questions:

1. For each of the following statements, indicate using a check (✓) the year in which the event took place.

Statement	1964	1940	1935	1929	1922
Charged with fraud involving the Black Star Line and sentenced to 5 years in prison.					
Released from prison and deported to Jamaica and Launched Jamaica's first modern political Party: People's Political Party					
Returned to England to continue his work.					
Died after suffering a stroke, buried in England					
Exhumed and returned to Jamaica to be interred at National Heroes Park.					

2. Marcus Garvey made a lot of contribution. In which century did he make the most significant contribution to our history? Give a brief explanation.

3. From your understanding, what was Garvey's aim in forming the UNIA? Name two things that he launched that helped to spread and support the aim of the UNIA.



4. Garvey was deported to Jamaica 1929 after his release from prison. Describe two significant events that took place upon Garvey's return to Jamaica.

5. In 1910 Garvey learnt that black people were suffering everywhere. When and how did he first learn this? Explain...

6. After Garvey's return to Jamaica in 1914, he established the UNIA. Why do you think Garvey used the 1st August 1914 to launch the UNIA?



7. Garvey died after he suffered a stroke in 1940 and was buried in England. Explain how World War II could have prevented Garvey's body to be taken back to Jamaica?

8. In 1929, Garvey launched Jamaica's first modern political Party: People's Political Party. Give one possible reason why the PPP did not get the support Marcus hoped for.

9. Write two adjectives that you would use to describe Garvey and explain the reason for your choice.
